

MNNIT ALUMNI STAR ACHIEVER AWARD

(DRAFT PROPOSAL)

Awards are motivators. Awards can help set milestones and targets. But, awards can be controversial or can be bought as well. To keep things simple we would like to introduce achiever's awards for the members which will be mainly for the purpose of publicizing the great work our fellow alumni are doing to serve the nation and society. Mainly it will be modeled on people's choice awards, with a difference of not restricting it to a specific number or categories.

It is proposed to recognize distinguished fellow alumni of Lucknow Chapter, so that other alumni can be inspired by their work. The proposed modus operandi will be broadly as follows.

- Proposal shall be invited by the award seekers', detailing their work done which is exceptional and can be qualitatively and quantitatively assessable.
- All such proposals shall be put on Lucknow chapter website and lucknowmoti facebook page, where it will be available for view and voting for at least two months. Such proposals will also frequently emailed to chapter members for publicity and awareness of work being done by alumni members.
- The proposal and votes given by members of lucknow chapter shall be reviewed by executive committee of the chapter. Executive committee can also co-opt any number of experts if required to access a certain proposal. System of voting will be open to scrutiny by any member of the association. Details will be published when the final proposal is shown on website.
- Finally the awards shall be announced and widely publicised.
- The number of awards shall be based on the quality of the proposal received. None, all or a given percentage out of total applications may be selected, based on the given criteria selected by the executive committee.
- The detailed proposal for inviting applications shall be soon drafted after detailed discussions and will be published on site and shall be emailed to every member.
- Sponsorship for these awards shall be made open to any alumni or any outside agency as well. Sponsor will however can not be a part of any decision making process of the award.
- Awards will generally be open to Alumni Life Members of the chapter.
- Exceptional contribution and achievement if done by a non-life member alumni can also be considered, if it is generally accepted by members.
- Awards shall be given in each financial year and a person who has received it in any year can be selected again only if it is for any extraordinary new achievement, but not before a minimum gap as decided by the members.
- What shall be given as award, shall be decided by the executive committee of each financial year, based upon the available financial resources in a given year.
- The purpose of this scheme needs to be seen in the light of publicizing alumni work and not for creating any comparative or benchmarks, so participation in this will be completely voluntary.
